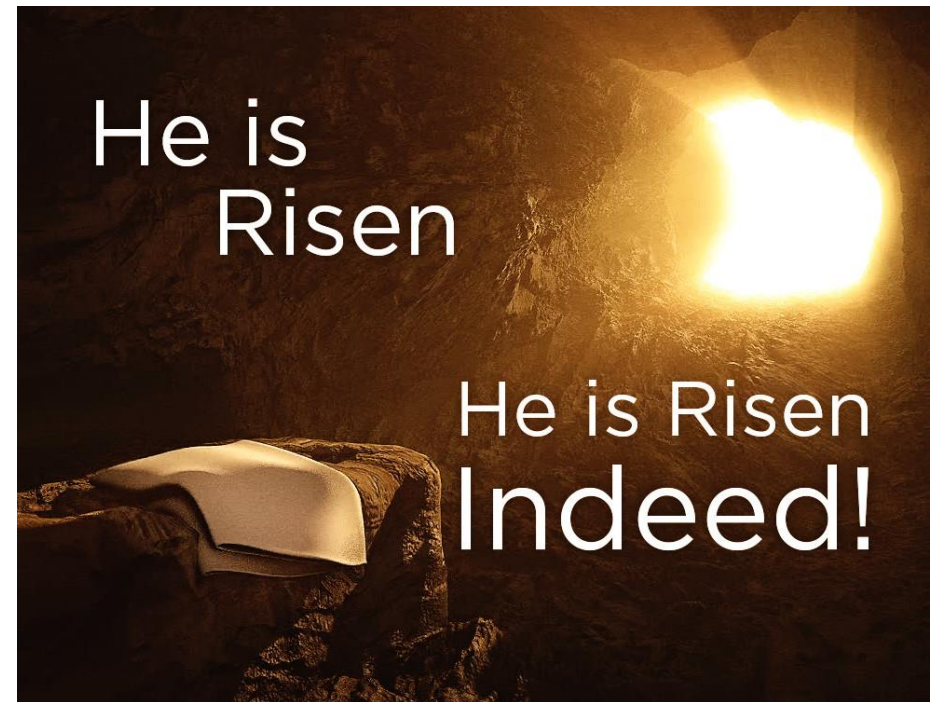

In this eight-session DVD Bible study, author and pastor Andy Stanley will take us on a Bible study journey through the Gospels as he traces Jesus' teaching on what it means to follow.

Lots of people think Christianity is all about doing what Jesus says. But what if doing what Jesus says isn't what Jesus says to do at all? Jesus' invitation is an invitation to relationship, and it begins with a simple request: follow me. Jesus doesn't expect people to be perfect. He just wants us to follow him. Being a sinner doesn't disqualify anyone. Being an unbeliever doesn't disqualify anyone. In fact, following almost always begins with a sinner and unbeliever taking one small step.
