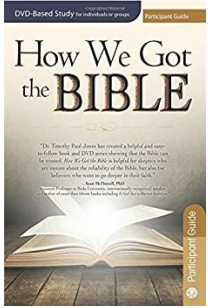

A 6 week DVD Series starting on June 26th in person and on zoom.

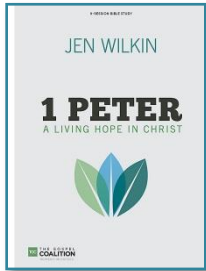
Dr. Timothy Paul Jones gives easy-to-understand answers to popular questions on the Bibles reliability and accuracy.

He shares his concerns on big picture issues for the early church, describes believers' true identity in Christ, and ultimately helps readers discover what it means to experience the Living Hope they have in Christ. Key themes of

humility, submission, and identity in Christ guide the study of 1 Peter as participants are challenged to read the book in its entirety each week.
