



## Sunday School Hour -Bible Character Study starting June 30<sup>th</sup>




The Adult Sunday School class will be looking at various people in the Bible this summer. They all have their own story, their own faith journey. God used them all, regardless of who they were, where they came from, and

Alpha begins Thursday, September 5<sup>th</sup> at the Look-Up Center. Please see Peggy Lieb or Kim Dershem if you have questions.




