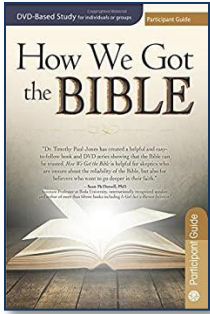

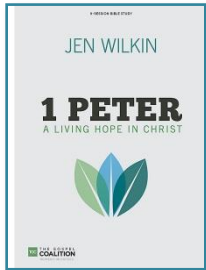
Operation Christmas Child Collection
