invited; Topic – *What are the priorities of the PC (USA) in addressing poverty in rural America?*

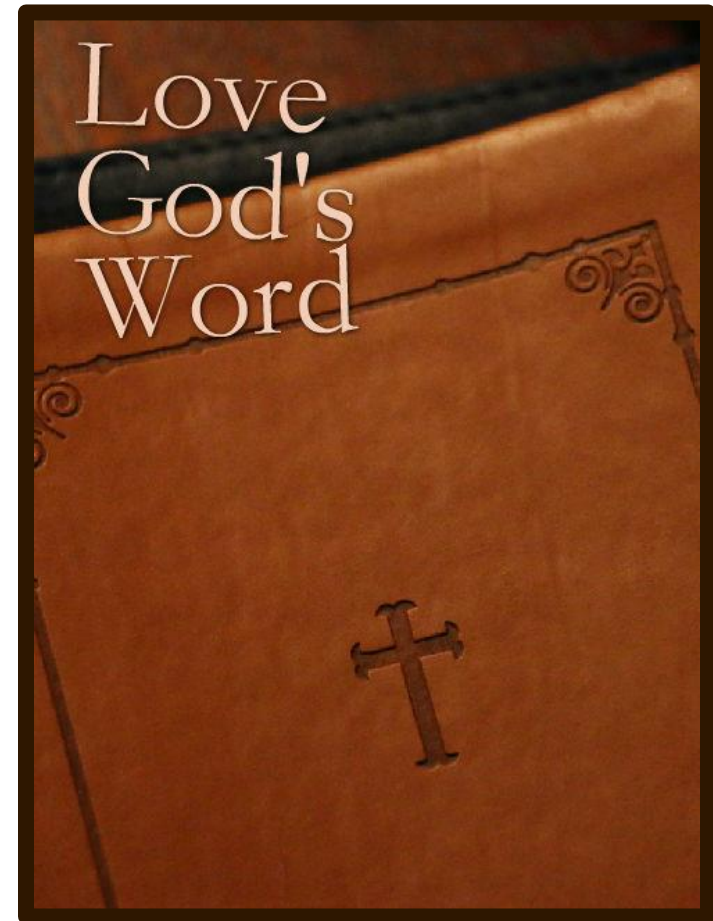

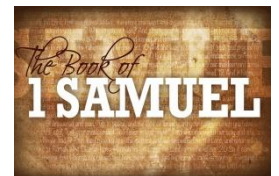

Lunch Bunch will meet at **noon** at the Trout Club on **August 21**. Please come and join us for a great time of fellowship.



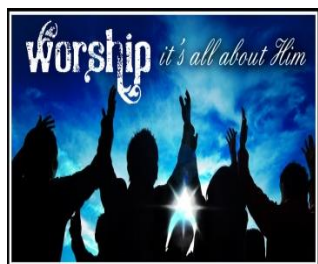
Alpha
