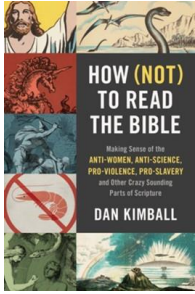

Operation Christmas Child Collection

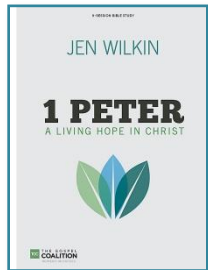
