~ Prayer Requests~

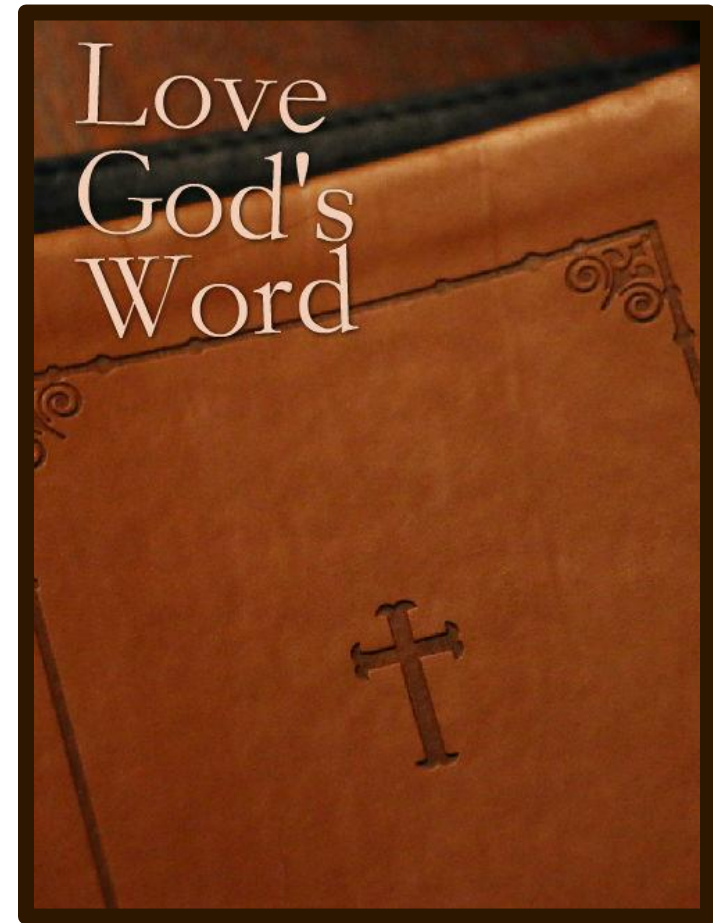
