~ Prayer Requests~

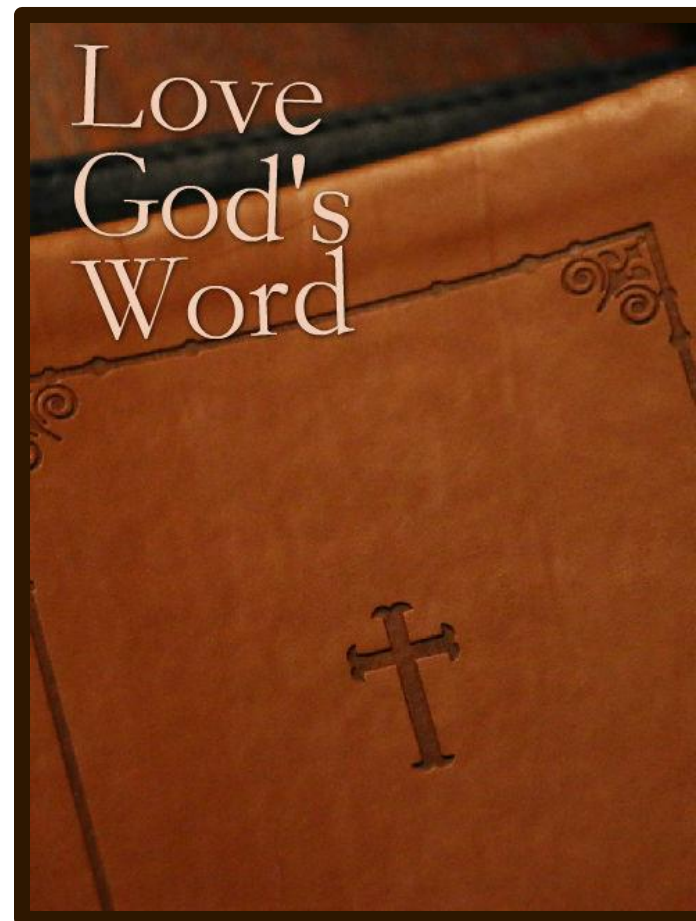

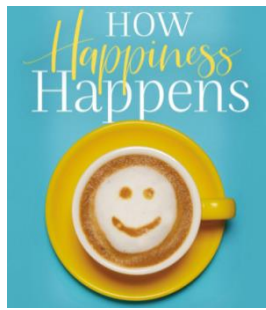

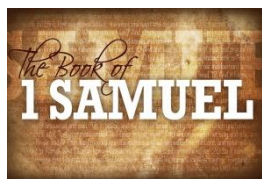
