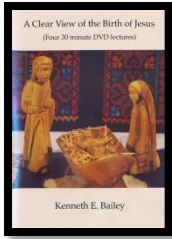

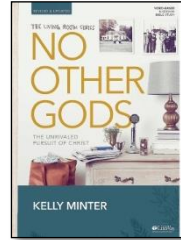
Adult Sunday School
