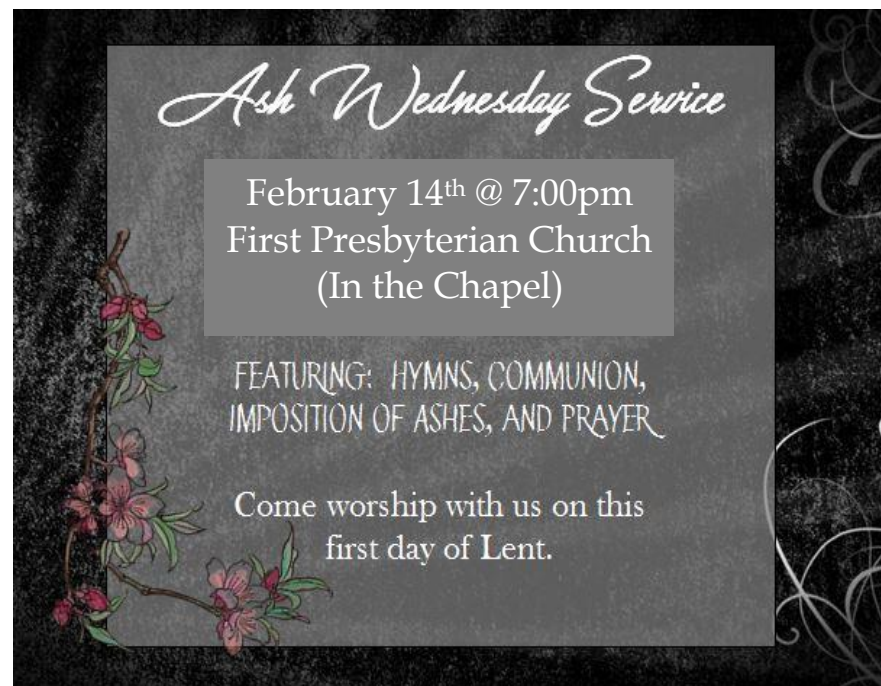

Choir Cantata

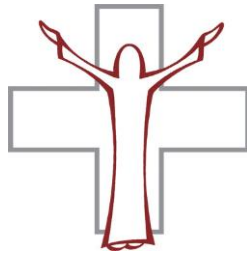

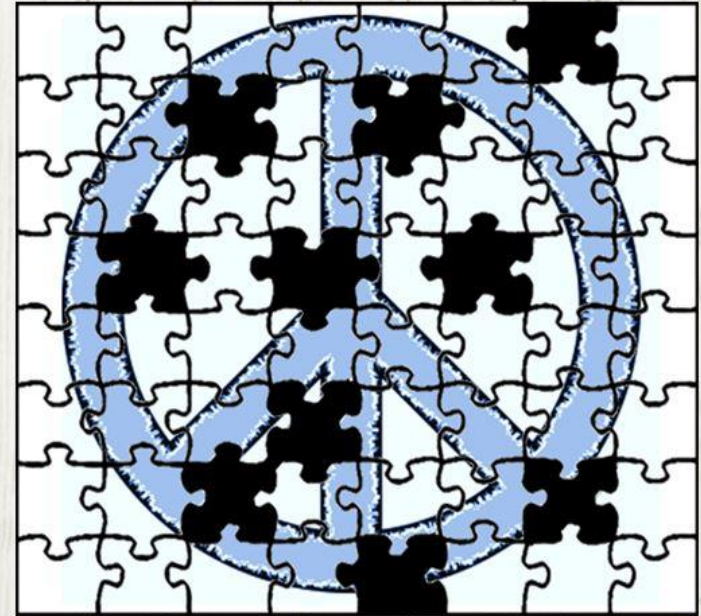
