
The Good Morning Bible study is

Body of Proof by apologist Dr. Jeremiah Johnston, runs through the month of April. Culture is doing its best to convince the world there is nothing special about Jesus. And many Christians never get beyond a Sunday school understanding of their own faith. As a result, Christianity's most important historical fact-the resurrection-is often

the most misunderstood, relegated to Easter and funeral services, creating a powerless Christianity.

The single most important fact of the Christian faith is that Jesus isn't dead. He was resurrected on a Sunday morning two thousand years ago. That one weekend included His execution, an earthquake, daytime darkness, an uprising, and a miracle unlike any the world had ever seen.
