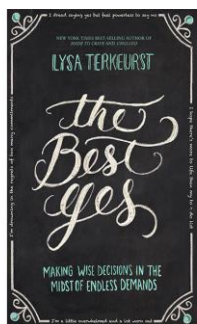
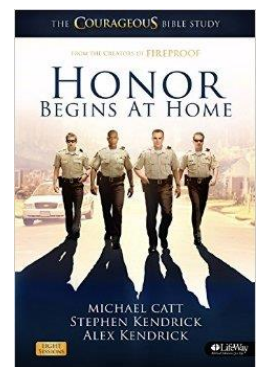


Sunday Morning Adult Elective:
