Nov. 20th will be the Hanging of the green. More details to follow but please mark your calendars. Nov 27th is the first Sunday of Advent

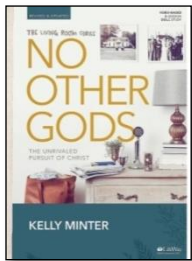
Sights and Sounds is Thursday, December 1st from 6:00pm-8:30pm.
