FINANCIAL UPDATE

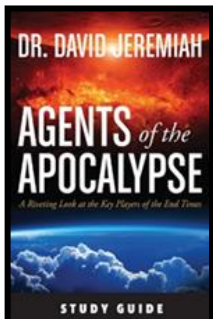
Session has approved spending approximately \$35,000 to replace the sanctuary air conditioners.

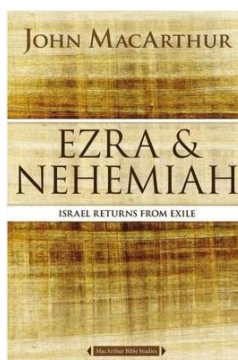

Good Morning Bible Study meets on Thursday mornings in the Fellowship Hall from 10:00-12:00.

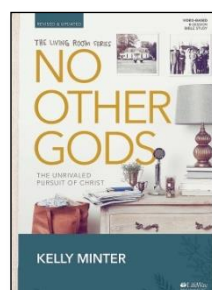


Coming Soon!

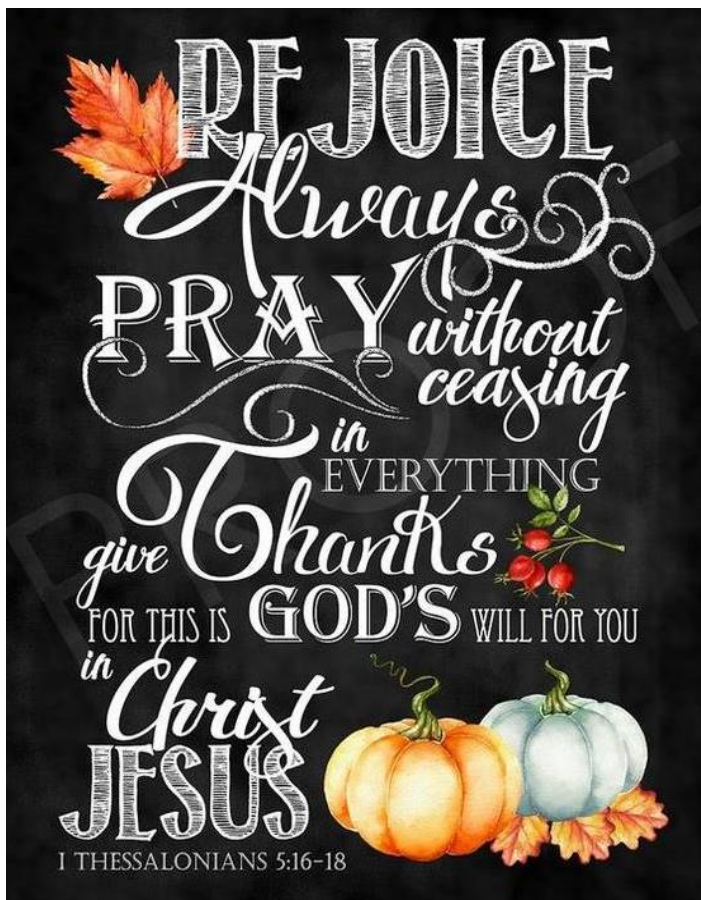
