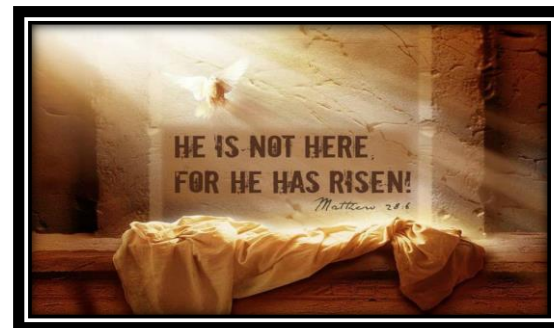

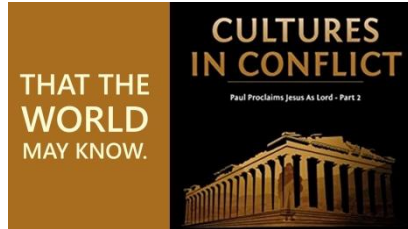

**Starting Strong Apartment Supplies:**

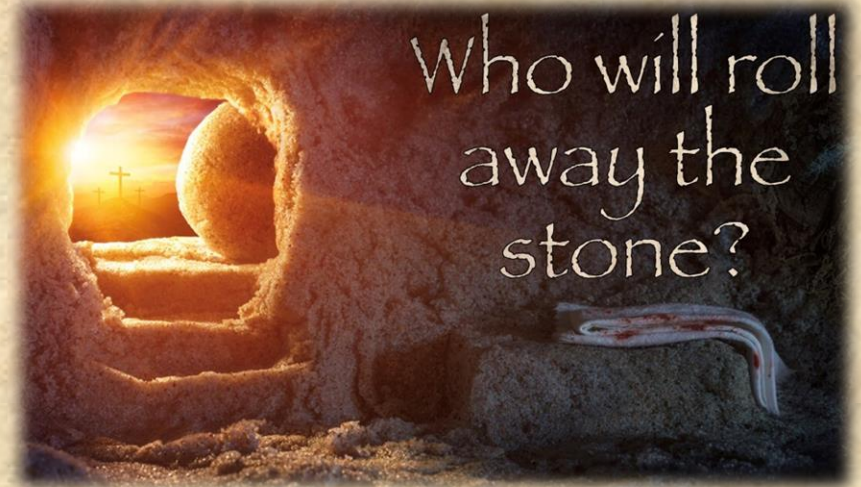
